- Special Education – typically requires a separate or additional Interdistrict Agreement.
- Record Sharing
- Administration of district or state assessments.
- **Resident District/School will be responsible to notify *Internet Academy* in the event that the total FTE declared exceeds the amount indicated as stated above.**

NOTE: Unless otherwise addressed in the agreement, the responsibility for the student remains with the resident school district (special ed., CSRS, graduation requirements, state assessments [WASL], etc).
