credit retrieval

Who is eligible? High school students who have already taken a specific course, and not earned credit, may apply to take the course as credit retrieval.

A TRANSCRIPT IS REQUIRED.

By demonstrating mastery of the standards throughout the course, the student will earn a C grade and .5 high school credit.
